As of June 1, 2018 cub scouts was open to girls as well. If your daughter would be interested in joining we would love for her to! The girls will meet at the same time but be in a different den. The girls will get to participate in the same activities as the boys and will earn everything that the boys can earn. Girls can participate in Cub Scouts along side of Girl Scouts. Both are offered at no charge.

Latch Key Boy Scouts allows students to participate without having to attend meetings outside of Latch Key. There are few times that the students will have the opportunity to participate outside of the program.
